# Maths

## Year 2

<b>Number and place value</b>	Numbers to one hundred, hundreds, partition, recombine, more/less
<b>Measure</b>	Quarter past/to, metres, kilometers, grams, kilograms, millimeters, liters, temperature, degrees
<b>Geometry (position and direction)</b>	Rotation, clockwise, anticlockwise, straight line, ninety degree turn, right angle
<b>Geometry (properties of shape)</b>	Size, bigger, larger, smaller, symmetrical, line of symmetry, fold, match, mirror line, reflection, pattern, repeating pattern
<b>Fractions</b>	Three quarters, one third, a third, equivalence, equivalent
<b>Data/statistics</b>	Count, tally, sort, vote, graph, block graph, pictogram, represent, group, set, list, table, label, title, most popular, most common, least popular, least common
<b>Problem solving</b>	Predict, describe the pattern, describe the rule, find, find all, find different, investigate
